COVID-19 INFORMATION

We are happy to announce that the European Colorectal Congress can be held in-person.

Due to the current development of the Corona pandemic, the Federal Council of Switzerland has decided on farreaching opening steps for exhibitions and congresses. Among others, the upper limits for events are dropped.

For vaccinated, recovered and tested persons, no restrictions apply to the congress.

This means that distance rules and the obligation to wear masks will no langer apply to these participants, provided that no new virus variant appears against which the vaccinations are only insufficiently effective.

To ensure the safety of all participants, we will ask for a Covid certificate (vaccinated, tested, recovered) together with personal identification at the entrance to the congress.

All entrants must present a completed entry form. Participants from non-EU countries (e.g. USA, Emirates) unfortunately have to have their certificate converted into a Swiss certificate. This can be done for a processing fee of 30.- CHF via the following website:

The Swiss certificate will be sent to the participant by email as a PDF. This can also be transferred via transfer code into the Swiss Covid-Zertifikat APP.
